Today, March 31st 2023, at POLITEKNIK NEGERI MALANG – INDONESIA and TOKAT GAZIOSMANPAŞA UNIVERSITY - TURKEY we, the parties are as follows:

1. **Mr. Supriatna Adhisuwignjo, Director** of Politeknik Negeri Malang on behalf of Politeknik Negeri Malang located at Jl. Soekarno Hatta 09 Malang, East Java later in this MOA referred to as **“PARTY A”**
2. **Prof. Dr. Fatih YILMAZ, Rector** of Tokat Gaziosmanpaşa University , on behalf of Tokat Gaziosmanpaşa University , located at Gaziosmanpaşa Üniversitesi, Taşlıçiftlik Yerleşkesi, 60250 Merkez/Tokat Merkez/Tokat, Turki, later in this MoA referred to as **“PARTY B”**

Both parties later in this MoA referred to as **“THE PARTIES”** agreed to cooperate in the implementation of 2nd International Management, Accounting, and Business Tournament (TREASURE) 2023.

WHEREAS:

- A. Politeknik Negeri Malang / Party A as Host University is an established university state-owned legal entity which has a vision to become one of leading teaching and research higher education institution in education, industrial engineering and culture both regionally and globally.
- B. Tokat Gaziosmanpasa University / Party B as Co-Host University is a state university that offers undergraduate, graduate and doctorate education opportunities in several different programs including human, experimental and right sciences. Tokat Gaziosmanpasa University promotes diversity and fosters a genuine connection between research, education, and practice. It aims to be a national and global model of an innovative research university.

ARTICLE 1: DESCRIPTION OF CONTRACT

Based from an existing Memorandum of Understanding, both **PARTIES** will endeavor to take necessary steps to encourage and promote co-operation in implementing this International Competition. It is therefore, the intention and purposes of this MoA to build mutual cooperation between **THE PARTIES** in order to improve the program mobility.

ARTICLE 2: SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES

THE PARTIES, through this MoA, agreed to conduct activities with the following scope:

ARTICLE 3: DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. **PARTY A:** The Accounting Department of Politeknik Negeri Malang shall:
 - a. Provide information regarding the 2nd International Management, Accounting, and Business Tournament (TREASURE) 2023.
 - b. Ensure the eligibility of participants, in which they should come from bachelor or diploma degree.
 - c. Ensure that the competition is conducted in English.
 - d. Post the logo of Party B to be included on Treasure's Social Media, Flyer, Website, Virtual Background, Booklet and Certificate.
 - e. Facilitate the online competition, in which Politeknik Negeri Malang will be the one to accept and manage the registrations, sending the certificate and prize, and organize the review process.
 - f. Evaluate the cooperation implementation concurrently with Tokat Gaziosmanpasa University

2. **PARTY B:** Tokat Gaziosmanpasa University shall:
 - a. Dispatch 2 individuals or teams to join the Essay competition, another 2 individuals or teams to join the Poster competition, and another 2 individuals or teams to join the TikTok Video competition for **FREE**.
 - b. Arrange 1 lecturer as reviewer/judge to give his/her assessment before the final round of the competition.
 - c. Provide Information about the selected reviewer/judge.
 - d. Provide the university's profile, video and logo to be put on the Treasure's Social Media, Flyer, Website, Virtual Background and Certificate.
 - e. The reviewer/judge's assessment should be conducted based on the provided matrix and deliver it on time to the committee.

- f. Evaluate the cooperation implementation concurrently with **Politeknik Negeri Malang**.

ARTICLE 4: EFFECTIVE DATE

1. This MoA is effective on the date of signing by **THE PARTIES** and until the date this MoA is revoked by **THE PARTIES** (on June 2023);
2. This MoA is to be implemented in accordance to **THE PARTIES'** agreement.

ARTICLE 5: EVALUATION

The evaluation of this MoA is carried out concurrently by **THE PARTIES** in every end of the program and can be used as a consideration to determine the continuation of the following year's cooperation.

ARTICLE 6: FORCE MAJEURE

1. The term "force majeure" refers to events such as natural disasters (earthquake, landslide, and flood), fire, war, riot, rebellion, strike, and epidemic, each of which has a direct impact on the competition's implementation and causes it to be postponed or cancelled.
2. In the event of force majeure, **THE PARTIES** must notify the other party within 3 (three) days of the event of force majeure by enclosing valid evidence; the same applies when the force majeure ends. The parties shall determine the necessity of meeting in order to address/resolve problems that may have arisen as a result of the force majeure.

ARTICLE 7: REVOCATION/ CONFLICT RESOLUTION

In the event of a conflict between **PARTY A** and **PARTY B**, all efforts must be made to resolve issues/problems amicably; otherwise, this Agreement will be terminated. In the event that this agreement is terminated, projects that were started during the time this agreement was in effect will be continued with the full support of the respective institutions until they are completed.


ARTICLE 8: CLOSING

**PROTOCOL BETWEEN
TOKAT GAZIOSMANPAŞA UNIVERSITY
(TURKEY)
AND
POLITEKNIK NEGERI MALANG
(INDONESIA)
Nomor: 7503/PL2/HK/2023**

Article 1

This protocol comprises the joint scientific work and educational and cultural collaboration between Tokat Gaziosmanpaşa University and Politeknik Negeri Malang.

Article 2

This protocol has been composed with the main aims of encouraging the research and educational approaches of Tokat Gaziosmanpaşa University and Politeknik Negeri Malang between the teaching staff, assistants, researchers, experts, and students of both universities, developing existing relations, enabling the joint use of research work results and publishing these results, and transferring the experiences of the parties in educational approaches and in the joint scientific organizations.

Article 3

Both parties Tokat Gaziosmanpaşa University and Politeknik Negeri Malang acknowledge to undertake the following articles that make up the whole of this protocol and the terms of its application for the realization of these articles.

Article 4

Both parties will work in the fields they will collaborate with within the framework determined above and the criteria clearly determined below, and they will exchange scientific knowledge, technological know-how and experience. In this context:

Article 5

- a) Both universities will endeavor to provide exchange for students with a scientific approach. The number of students to benefit from the exchange process will be

determined by a joint commission to be formed following the signing of the protocol by both parties based on mutual understanding. The host university will be notified of the names and fields of education of the students determined by the sending university at least three months beforehand and the host university will announce its decision regarding applications to the other party at least 1 month before the commencement of the academic year.

- b) Both universities will exempt visiting students from charges such as education and registration fees. The principal procedure requires that such charges are paid at the institution to which the student is attached to. All social payments other than education and registration fees will be met by students.
- c) Students - excluding tuition and registration fees - will be subject to the regulations of the host university. The sending university will accept the examinations of the host university and their results.
- d) For application, students will present a document demonstrating his/her language proficiency meeting the terms and level required by the host university.
- e) Each participant will be responsible for his/her travel expenses and expenses incurred from travel documents. Upon request, the host institution will assist the visiting student for suitable accommodation. Accommodation costs will not exceed the prices paid by native students. Visiting students will also have the right to benefit from all the privileges of the campus (e.g. the use of libraries, student canteens and social facilities etc.) that native students have and at the same prices.
- f) Each participant should obtain a health and accident insurance against any medical problems or accidents that may be faced during their exchange period in their own country prior to their travel. The insurance company and the limit of the insurance should be valid in the host country.
- g) Necessary procedures will be implemented for the recognition of awards, certificates and documents of attendance awarded to the visiting student for participating to seminars, courses, etc. during his/her stay at the host university.

Article 6

After having been approved by official governmental authorities this protocol will be considered valid for five (5) years once signed by the appropriate officials of each university. Three months before the end of the protocol duration, the conditions of the protocol will be reviewed. Accordingly, the protocol will be extended for another five



years or will be cancelled. Requests for withdrawal from the protocol must be in writing. This notification must be given at least one (1) year prior to the termination of the five (5) year program.
