



Agreement of Cooperation

Between European University and Tokat Gaziosmanpaşa University

European University and Tokat Gaziosmanpaşa University enter into this general agreement to foster international cooperation in medical education and research, exchange and cooperative initiatives:

1. Both institutions agree that this document creates the foundation on which a productive and positive long-term relationship can be built. The following exchange activities are examples of shared programs that can take place through the partnership:

- a. Exchange of academic personnel (professors, lecturers, or researchers) in terms of bilateral, Erasmus+ and other international funding programmes.
- b. Exchange of students (including undergraduate and graduate students) in terms of bilateral, Erasmus+ and other international programmes.
- c. Exchange and sharing of academic information, experience and materials.
- d. Exchange of periodical academic publications.
- e. Organization of joint research programs.
- f. Organization of joint conferences, training sessions and courses.
- g. Other academic exchanges agreed to by both universities.

2. Both institutions will work together to seek and identify public, private or institutional funds to support research and scholarly opportunities for students and staff of both institutions.

3. Both institutions will work cooperatively to find public or private funds to finance, over the long term, scholarships for undergraduate, single level and graduate exchange students from both universities.

4. Both institutions will cooperate to create research opportunities to meet the academic, intellectual and creative needs of both institutions.

Agreement Validity

1. The sides are permitted to rightful changes based on preapproval that should be documented in the written form and sealed with the signature of both parties.

2. The agreement is effective immediately for a period of validity of 10 years.

3. If one of the parties does not inform the other party regarding ceasing the agreement, in a month notice, the contract will be renewed automatically for the period of 10 years on the terms formulated above.



Concluding Regulations

1. The sides take complete liability to comply with the demands of the Agreement;
2. During the period of the treaty validity, the parties are obliged to respect each other, decide all debatable issues and subjects under mutual consent and in complete compliance with contract.
3. If any un conformity arises, all debatable issues must be decided in accordance to laws of Georgia and the Republic of Turkey
4. The Contract is documented in English language, in duplicate with equal juridical value (for each party).

We have acknowledged the terms of the treaty; we agree and take full liability to carry them out.
